2026 TAXES

This year there has been NO CHANGE to the base

tax (\$550) or the mill rate (2.5 mills). The education (school) mill rate stayed at 4.27 mills. To receive the discount on the municipal portion of your taxes, your payment must be received in the office no later than August 31st. Ensure your payment is received in adequate time for processing. You may pay your taxes by cash, cheque or e-transfer. All receipts will be emailed to you if your email address is on file with the village.

Both postdated cheques and installments are accepted for the payment of your current and next year's taxes. Please contact the office to make these arrangements.

ADDRESSES

Your address printed on your tax notice and should be clearly posted on your cottage as this will assist in locating you in an emergency. Bylaw 4/91 requires posting your address on your property and provides a penalty for non-compliance.

Tax and Assessment notices can also be emailed directly to you along with current newsletters on the day they are postal mailed. Contact the office for details.

BOAT LAUNCH/PARKING ACCESS

Keys for the gates remain the property of the municipality. Should you sell your cottage, please remember to turn your keys into the office. Parking passes are included with your tax notice or separate mail. Haven't picked up your key yet or have no parking pass—please contact the office.

METZ AVENUE BEACH PARKING

Parking is available behind Metz Avenue to the south for vehicles and trailers to ensure the safety and access to all in the area. Watch for signage.

PUBLIC RESERVES/ROADWAYS

Please remember that no permanent structures can be placed in these areas. Prior to construction or placing of any lifts, pump houses or water systems on the shoreline area, an approved permit from Council is required.

HYGIENIC WATER SYSTEM

The village operates a hygienic water system in Lipp's Beach subdivision by permit. The water provided to these cottages cannot be used for drinking, cooking or oral hygiene. Please place "DO NOT DRINK" stickers on or near your taps in the cottage and ensure all family, friends and visitors are advised. Additional stickers may be obtained from the administrator. Please note that the water fees have increased this year and are reflected in the invoice you receive. The annual water quality notice is posted at the well and on the village website.

FIRE SUPPRESSION SERVICES

The Village of Holdfast provides the local volunteer firefighting services for our village. Please ensure that you have adequate fire insurance coverage on your property. **Note:** The current fire call-out fees are \$800.00 per hour per truck from time of call out. A fee of \$800.00 will be charged for request for assistance that is cancelled on route. You may use these costs to ensure adequate coverage in your discussions with your insurer. Additional coverage

specifically for volunteer fire fighting callouts should be discussed and is usually reasonably priced.

ATV's

Remember that children between the ages of 12 and 16 must be accompanied by a person with a valid driver's license and helmets **must** be worn by all riders at all times. This is a privilege to use ATVs in the village and your cooperation will ensure it remains so.

BYLAW ENFORCEMENT

Regional Bylaw Services continue to provide bylaw enforcement services for the village.

SPEEDING

Please watch your speed and especially pedestrian traffic in the village keeping families safe as they walk to the beaches.

NOISE

For the enjoyment of all residents, quiet time is between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Please respect your neighbors.

GOLF CART BYLAW

For the enjoyment of all residents, Council with SGI has an approved bylaw that allows Golf Carts to be used within the boundaries of the municipality with certain conditions. You must have a valid driver's license. Please check out our website for all the details.



BUILDING PERMITS

Remember that building and development permits are required and must be approved PRIOR to construction. Any building commenced without a permit will be issued a stop work order, fee charged and also may need to be dismantled,

moved or otherwise altered at your expense. Building permits start at \$40.00 plus building inspection and SAMA fees and can be obtained by contacting the office.

Demolition permits are required for removal or demolition of any building or structure at no charge for the permit. Obtaining a permit ensures that your property is assessed correctly which affects your annual tax bill.

Pump House permits and location are approved by Council and are required prior to construction. **There is no charge for the pump house permit and must be approved before construction.**

****STEEL RECYCLE/GARBAGE****

GREEN STEEL RECYCLE BIN is available. ONLY STEEL IN THE GREEN BIN - money paid to village from the steel goes to the social club for funding.

FRIDGES, FREEZERS or PROPANE TANKS ARE NOT PERMITTED!) Please keep the area neat and stack items to the front of the bin maximizing space to ensure everyone has access to use the bins.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS – Please visit the new blue Loraas recycling bins by the waste bins!!!! Please break down large boxes.

TREE PIT – ****Remember**** – Council has an agreement with Alice Beach for access to the tree pit and grass clippings area. *We pay for use of the disposal area for trees and clear wood products only (no paint or treatment).* Any other items placed in the tree pit will result in fines to offenders—please be conscious of what you put in the pit and remember that Alice Beach regulates the area.

GRASS CLIPPINGS – These compostable items are to be placed in the clearly marked area

at Alice Beach. **Do not place plastic bags, rocks and wood products anywhere in the area as it is monitored and violators may be fined.**
